

Modular designed Bosch R 5 oil-sealed rotary vane vacuum pumps are single stage, air-cooled, and direct-driven. This oil-recirculating design is one of the simplest and most reliable vacuum pumps available on the world market. 

Operating Principle



Operating Principle

Rotation of the pump rotor, which is mounted eccentrically in the pump cylinder, traps entering vapor between rotor vane segments. As rotation continues, vapor is compressed and discharged into the exhaust box.

Vapors then pass through several stages of internal oil and mist eliminators to remove lubricating oil from the exhaust. The oil that is separated is then returned to the oil reservoir.

Additional features include an automotive type spin-on oil filter, and a built-in inlet anti-suckback valve that prevents the pump from rotating backwards.

A built-in gas ballast permits pumping with high water vapor loads and provides oil drying for maximum performance.




